## **GMR 3-D Scanning Spotlight**



GMR utilizes the latest 3D laser scanning technologies for data collection and documentation in the architecture, facilities management, engineering, and construction industries. 3D laser scanning produces fast and highly accurate existing conditions data which minimizes errors and omissions, provides increased productivity, and can reduce costs on projects. This type of scanned as-built imagery transforms the planning and engineering of projects to create the highest level of accuracy and usability.

GMR is staffed with a team of professionals that are highly trained in capturing and processing the detailed imagery across multiple project applications. The GMR team is focused on delivering an exceptional product with a long-term client commitment to ensure expectations are met for every single project.

### **Design Fieldwork**

The most efficient method for providing accurate field measurements for design is with 3D laser scanning. GMR incorporates the use of 3D laser scanning in acquiring all existing field condition data to create a digital site drawing for design projects. The 3D image can be converted into 2D AutoCAD linework to use in design.

### **As-Builts**

Accurate 2D building plans can be created with the use of 3D laser scanning. GMR is experienced in creating interior and exterior as-built plan sets, which can be used for building maintenance, building inventory, and renovations. In addition, 360 degree photograph services can be incorporated to create a comprehensive architectural or engineering package. This as-built package provides a record of what was actually built and allows a full record of change to be tracked as improvements are completed and documented.

### **Construction Documentation**

3D laser scanning can be used during building construction workflow to help reduce construction conflicts and rework. Colored imagery is processed into a 3D view that replicates being on-site during different project milestones. In addition, the imagery can be used to compare the newly constructed work against the engineered design drawings for quality assurance and control.
